- 3. Two letters of recommendation: One from his or her school and the other from an extra-curricular/community group. Wherever possible, letters should be on letterhead and signed.
- 4. Original transcript(s) of applicant's grades.
- 5. Proof of acceptance to a recognized Canadian university or college
